

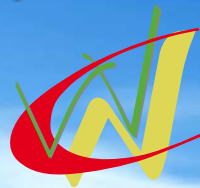

At The National Gathering you can explore these questions and many other themes ranging from the local church to global challenges, from personal faith to generational issues. Features will include:

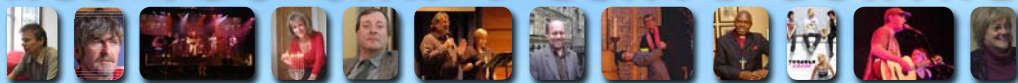
- World-renowned speakers
